How much of my final grade are OCEs worth?

- ❖ ENGR 100, 101, 102, 199 – 5% of your final grade.

How many OCEs do I have to attend?

- ❖ ENGR 100, 101, and 199 – 5 OCEs (2 DV & 3 OCE)
- ❖ ENGR 102 – 5 OCEs (1 DV & 4 OCE)

Where do I find OCEs?

- ❖ The Freshman Engineering website (<http://www.cemr.wvu.edu/freshman>)
- ❖ Bulletin board across from ESB G-11
- ❖ E-mail from CEMR-Studylabs@mail.wvu.edu
- ❖ We only provide some OCE opportunities, it is your job as an engineering student to find some on your own

What does NOT count as an OCE?

- ❖ Anything that is required or already part of your grade. For example, career fairs.
- ❖ Anything that is not related to engineering.

Are there any OCE required for any ENGR class?

- ❖ For ENGR 100, 101, or 199 – you must attend 2 department visitations
- ❖ For ENGR 102 – you must attend 1 department visitation

I'm exempt for study labs; do I still have to go to OCEs?

- ❖ Yes. You cannot be exempt from Out of Class Experiences.

Can I save all my OCE forms till the end and turn them all in at once?

- ❖ No. You must turn in your OCE forms in within one week of attending the OCE.

How can I check to see how may OCEs I have attended?

- ❖ OCE attendance will be posted on the Freshman Engineering website (<http://www.cemr.wvu.edu/freshman/studylabs/>). You should check your attendance record on a regular basis.
