How much are study labs worth?

- ❖ ENGR 101, 102, 293 – 10% of your final grade
- ❖ ENGR 199 – 33% of your final grade

My grades were really good last semester; do I still have to go to study labs?

- ❖ If you earned a GPA of 3.5 or better, you are exempt from the first 5 weeks of classes *only*.

I took my first set of tests, and I did really well; do I still have to go to study labs?

- ❖ If you earned A's on ALL your math and science classes, you will be exempt from study labs the week that you turn in a signed exemption form.

I have nothing to study this week; do I still have to go to study labs?

- ❖ You will be allowed one (1) free week where you do not have to attend study labs.
- ❖ During mid-semester, Freshman Engineering will be sponsoring a food drive. While not mandatory, if you participate you will be allowed one (1) extra free week of study labs.

Can I save all my study lab forms till the end and turn them all in at once?

- ❖ No. You must turn in your study lab forms by Friday of each week you attend. Forms will no longer be taken in 'stacks.'

How can I check to see how may study labs I have attended?

- ❖ Study lab attendance will be posted on eCampus. You should check your attendance record on a regular basis
